(Curriculum Topic: History KS2 The Romans)

During this day of discovery, children will step back in time to become Roman soldiers, traveling across the seas to England. We will find out why the Romans came here, how they survived and what they had to do to try and stay! Children will explore all aspects of Roman culture including what they left behind. Be prepared for an action packed day that might leave us all getting a little wet!



During the day we will:

- Explore the reasons for the invasion
- Row our way across the seas
- Construct tents out of den building materials for the army
- Build a wall to keep out the Picts
- Make a human aqueduct using real water!

At the end of the day children will:

- Understand the importance of the Roman army and the empire
- Be able to identify the cultural impact of the Romans on Britain
- Identify and place Hadrian's wall and why it was built
- Use teamwork to have a deeper understanding of how the Roman army worked and was so successful
- Understand some of the problems facing the Romans in Britain
